

**COMPLIANCE WITH ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S
RENOVATION, REPAIR, AND PAINTING (RRP) RULE REGARDING LEAD
PAINT**

above-referenced project (the "Project") as follows:

1. The Grantee/Borrower recognizes that common renovation activities like sanding, cutting, and demolition can create hazardous lead dust and chips by disturbing lead-based paint, which can be harmful to adults and children. To protect against this risk, on April 22, 2008, the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"), issued a rule requiring the use of lead-safe practices and other actions aimed at preventing lead poisoning. This rule is known as the Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule ("the RRP Rule").

2. The Grantee/Borrower recognizes that the RRP Rule which took effect on April 22, 2010, applies to renovation or rehabilitation on any housing constructed before 1978. The RRP Rule requires that renovations upon such housing must be performed only by renovators who have been properly trained and certified in accordance with EPA requirements.

3. The Grantee/Borrower acknowledges that the requirements of the RRP are fully contained at 40 CFR Part 745, and the Grantee/Borrower has reviewed and understands those requirements.

4. The Grantee/Borrower is responsible for all renovation performed on this project, and shall ensure that any renovation performed on this project after April 22, 2010, shall be conducted only by entities that are in compliance with the requirements of 40 CFR Part 745.
