



POSITIVE OUTCOMES FOR RECOVERY KENTUCKY CLIENTS

Recovery Kentucky was created to help Kentuckians recover from substance abuse, which often leads to chronic homelessness. There are 15 Recovery Kentucky centers across the Commonwealth, providing housing and recovery services for up to 1,800 persons simultaneously.

SIGNIFICANT REDUCTIONS IN PAST-6-MONTH SUBSTANCE USE


