A 2022 K-Count Sub-Assessment must be completed for each client (including children) residing in an HMIS participating Emergency Shelter or Transitional Housing project on **the night of 2/23/2022**. This form is optional and is intended to assist you in collecting this information for each client so that you can enter the client responses into HMIS later. You may enter the information directly into HMIS while asking the client the questions if you prefer.

Obtaining the *client name, birthdate, and other ID* information below is suggested to make sure you know which client belongs to which assessment. You can collect whatever information you think is appropriate so long as you are able to accurately record the client-specific responses contained on this form in the appropriate HMIS client profile.

You should complete a **separate form** for each member of a household. For children who are part of a household with an adult/guardian, an adult can respond on behalf of the child. **PLEASE MAKE SURE THE CLIENT UNDERSTANDS THEIR PARTICIPATION IS OPTIONAL**. If they refuse to provide answers, please provide a response to any of the questions you are sure about given your current or previous engagement with the client.

8. Are you currently experiencing homelessness because you are fleeing domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking?

9. (If No), In your own words, can you tell me what caused you to become homeless this time?
